

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ROAD-RIGHT-OF-WAY EQUIPMENT FROM SOURCEWELL COOPERATIVE PURCHASING CONTRACT (COKC00007), ESTIMATED COST \$100,000, APRIL 25, 2025, THROUGH APRIL 24, 2026.

WHEREAS, the Alternative Speed Abatement Program (ASAP), initiated in 2017, is the work of the Traffic and Transportation and staff with the support from the Municipal Counselor's Office; and

WHEREAS, the goal of the program is to reduce the frequency and magnitude of speeding within neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the program provides Oklahoma City's organized neighborhood associations, neighborhood groups, schools, and residents the ability to be active participants in helping to maintain safe and reasonable travel speeds on the streets where they live by requesting matching funds for installation of speed abatement items as described below; and

WHEREAS, on January 17, 2023 (Item No. XI. N), City Council approved an amendment to ASAP; and

WHEREAS, the program changes included a reduction in eligibility requirements; and

WHEREAS, four additional program features were approved (painted markings and messages), speed humps, speed cushions, and mini roundabouts; and

WHEREAS, program funding was changed from being entirely user-funded to a cost sharing model; and

WHEREAS, program funding is cost shared between program applicants and the City, as funds are available; and

WHEREAS, the City continues to reserve the right to remove program features should they become inoperative, damaged, destroyed, and for cause at any time; and

WHEREAS, costs will be split equally between the City and the applicant with the City performing the installations of the road-right-of-way equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City share is currently budgeted at \$50,000, funded by GOB funds, along with a \$50,000 match, funded by Special Purpose funds; and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell is a cooperative purchasing organization that provides government entities access to competitively solicited purchasing plans; and

WHEREAS, through Sourcewell, the City will procure goods and services using an established government contract, which adheres to bidding procedures that substantially comply with the City's requirements; and

WHEREAS, the approval process for this contract mirrors the procedures followed when purchasing from State contracts; and

WHEREAS, there is a continuing need for the utilization of these services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of The City of Oklahoma City that they do hereby authorize the purchase of road-right-of-way maintenance equipment from Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Contract, (COKC00007), estimated cost \$100,000, April 25, 2025, through April 24, 2026.
