

**RESOLUTION OF THE OKLAHOMA CITY PLANNING COMMISSION  
APPROVING THE PROPOSED 2025 GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND**

**WHEREAS**, 11 O.S. Section 47-109 et. Seq. of the Oklahoma State Statutes provides that once a comprehensive plan has been adopted, no capital project shall be constructed or authorized without approval of its location, character and extent by the Planning Commission of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Oklahoma City Zoning and Planning Code, §59-4300.2 requires that after the comprehensive plan is adopted, no street, square or other public way, ground or open space, public building or structure, or other governmental enterprise shall be constructed or authorized in the City, until the location, character, and extent of the use has been submitted to, and approved by, the Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, a comprehensive plan (plan~~okc~~) that guides the long-term growth and development of the city was adopted by the Planning Commission on July 9, 2015 and by the City Council on July 21, 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, it is a responsibility of the Planning Commission to assess whether the proposed 2025 General Obligation (GO) Bond Program is consistent with the comprehensive plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed 2025 GO Bond Program will impact the long-term growth and development of the city through investments in public facilities, streets, transit, parks, sidewalks, trails, libraries, economic development and affordable housing, public safety and drainage projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the City gathered public input regarding the 2025 GO Bond Program through multiple methods, including neighborhood/group meetings, eight public workshops, multiple survey tools, and on-line participation options including an interactive app; and

**WHEREAS**, through the public input process, The City received 6,030 recommendations from resident feedback through vision.okc.gov; and

**WHEREAS**, City staff compiled all project ideas received from the City Council, City departments, business groups, organizations and residents and applied prioritization criteria to evaluate the greatest need and priority for funding projects within each GO Bond proposition category; and

**WHEREAS**, this prioritization criteria included empirical data and guidance from the City's comprehensive plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Oklahoma City Planning Commission held a study session on May 29, 2025, to review and discuss the public input process and results, prioritization criteria methodology, and proposed GO Bond project list; and

**WHEREAS**, Planning Department staff reviewed proposed projects for consistency with the comprehensive plan and informed the Commission of staff's findings that the 2025 GO Bond Program is in conformance with the comprehensive plan;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the proposed 2025 General Obligation Bond Program, as shown in Exhibit A, is hereby approved and determined to be in conformance with the comprehensive plan.
