Acceptance of permanent easement, Project PC-0556, Roadway Widening Improvements, SW 59th Street from County Line Road to State Highway 152; and approving payment of claim, \$2,990.62. Ward 3.

**Location:**

SW 59th Street from County Line Road to State Highway 152

**Background:**

This 2017 General Obligation Bond project provides for the street widening of SW 59th Street from South County Line Road to State Highway 152. Improvements will include widening of the road from 2 lanes to 4 lanes, providing a storm drainage system and new sidewalk improvements. Acquisition of easements are needed to widen the street from 2 to 4-lanes.

This street widening project requires the purchase of additional easement at the Southwest corner of SW 59th Street and County Line Road that includes the relocation of existing public utilities within the newly expanded right-of-way. The additional easement will extend 10-feet into the City of Mustang's corporate limits along SW 59th Street and County Line Road. The City's current corporate limit ends 50-feet south of the section line of SW 59th Street running east and west and 50-feet west of County Line Road running north and south. The City of Mustang's City Council approved the permanent easement on September 12, 2023.

Final plans are expected Fall 2023 with construction expected to begin Late 2023 and be completed Late 2024.
