Honorable Chairman and Trustees:

I. SCOPE

Change Order No. 2 will substitute the Concrete Cable Mat with Flexamat.

II. JUSTIFICATION

Modifying the material required for the temporary stream crossing will reduce the project cost through lower material and labor costs.

Change Order No. 2 reduces pay items total and leaves the quantity and contract time unchanged for 116,480 SF of Concrete Cable Mat.

Change Order No. 1	\$ (300,000.00) (1.06% decrease)
Change Order No. 2	\$ (200,000.00) (0.71% decrease)
Revised Contract Amount	\$27,771,935.00

Change Order No. 2 is a decrease of \$ 200,000.00 or 0.71 percent below the original contract amount. Change Order Nos. 1 through 2 represent a decrease of \$ 500,000.00 or 1.77 percent below the original contract amount. The revised contract amount is \$ 27,771,935.00.

V. **CONTRACT TIME**

The original contract called for 870 calendar days. The total contract duration is now 870 calendar days.
