Background:

This project commissioned the repair and construction of approximately 6,960 linear feet of sanitary sewer main and connecting manholes due to advanced deterioration. Construction activities included necessary repairs to existing sewer infrastructure as well as the installation of new sewer manholes and mains to restore the operational capacity of the sanitary sewer system.

Travelers Casualty and Surety Company of America is the surety company for the two-year maintenance bond. Bond No. 107800167 will remain in effect until the contractor and surety have fulfilled all responsibilities under the maintenance bond
