WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the settlement of this lawsuit in the amount of \$30,000 is just and reasonable;

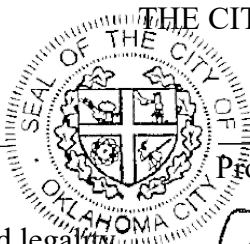


