**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL COUNSELOR TO CONFESS JUDGMENT WITHOUT ADMITTING LIABILITY IN THE CASE OF *KRISTIN CARON V. THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY*, OKLAHOMA COUNTY DISTRICT COURT CASE NO. CJ-2021-2241.**

**WHEREAS**, the lawsuit styled *Kristin Caron v. The City of Oklahoma City*, CJ-2021-2241 has been filed in the District Court of Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined that the settlement of this lawsuit in the amount of \$30,000 is just and reasonable;

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the City Council to make such settlement by authorizing the Municipal Counselor to draft the necessary paperwork to settle this lawsuit and to prepare and file a Journal Entry of Judgment, which does not admit liability in said case.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY** that the Municipal Counselor be and he is hereby directed to prepare and file any and all necessary paperwork to effectuate this settlement, including a Journal Entry of Judgment confessing Judgment without admitting liability.
