

RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT OF A \$194,000 GRANT FROM THE OKLAHOMA HIGHWAY SAFETY OFFICE BY ACCEPTING AN ADDITIONAL \$105,502.85; APPROVING THE AMENDED GRANT AGREEMENT; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY TREASURER TO RECEIVE AND DEPOSIT THE FUNDS IN THE GRANTS MANAGEMENT FUND.

WHEREAS, a resolution authorizing acceptance of a \$194,000 grant from the Oklahoma Highway Safety Office was previously approved by City Council on August 15, 2023 (Item No. VII.CH.); and

WHEREAS, this grant provides funding for the Oklahoma Impaired Driving Enforcement Drug Recognition Program (DRE). The DRE program is designed to assist in the identification and evaluation of drivers suspected to be under the influence of drugs leading to prosecution and adjudication of these impaired drivers, as directed by the Oklahoma Highway Safety Office (OHSO); and

WHEREAS, the grant provides funding for the Oklahoma City Police Department to coordinate and conduct training classes and certification sessions to train officers from various agencies in the state to become Drug Recognition Trainers and Experts to increase enforcement of DUI laws; and

WHEREAS, the grant period is October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the grant award is being increased to provide funding for a .85 FTE Drug Recognition Expert; and

WHEREAS, no City match is required with this grant from the Oklahoma Highway Safety Office; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Oklahoma City that the City is authorized to accept the amended award for the 2024

Oklahoma Highway Safety Office DRE Grant of an addition \$105,502.85.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of The City of Oklahoma City that the Mayor is authorized to execute the amended grant agreement, sign any necessary documents and the City Treasurer is authorized to receive and deposit these funds into Grants Management Fund 019.
