Amendment No. 2 to Public Art Commission Agreement with Ebony Iman Dallas, Quiquia Calhoun and Jarica Walsh, collectively DBA Nomad Mystique, LLC for a site-specific work of art for the Willa D. Johnson Recreation Center, 909 Frederick Douglass Avenue, increase of \$2,500. Ward 7.

**Location:**

909 Frederick Douglass Avenue, Ward 7.

**Purpose:**

Approve an Amendment to an Agreement with Nomad for a site-specific artwork titled Freedom to Dream.

**Background:**

An Agreement with Nomad was approved by City Council on March 16, 2021. During fabrication of the Work, delays in the construction process and changes to the design of the site caused an increase in Artists' expenses by \$7,769.67 above budgeted costs. Amendment No. 1 to Agreement was approved by the City Council on February 14, 2023 (Item No. IX.G.) Further construction delays have shortened the amount of time that Artists are allotted to install the work. In order to install in the required time Artists must hire additional personnel, leading to increased costs.

There are sufficient 1% for Art funds in the Contingency Budget for the project to increase payment to Nomad by \$2,500 in order to offset increased costs.
