Financial Impact Report**

An ordinance amending ordinance 26,950 as adopted by the City Council January 18, 2022, extending the corporate limits of the City of Oklahoma City; by correcting the legal description for such extension; by adding jurisdictional facts; and by specifying that the area for such extension shall continue to receive fire protection services from the Deer Creek Fire Protection District and that the Fire Protection District shall continue to receive its assessment without restriction; and declaring an Emergency. Ward 8

**Originating Department:** Planning Department

**Description of Impact**

This action will add approximately 160 acres of land area to the center line of May Avenue, extending one half a mile south of 206<sup>th</sup> Street to the existing City of Oklahoma Citys corporate limit.

**Summary of Impact**

**a. Cost to City Organization:** This amendment does not generate costs in addition to the potential costs identified in the ordinance adopted January 18, 2022. With this amendment, the subject property remains in the Deer Creek Fire Protection District; under this circumstance there may be a nominal impact to the City for potential public safety and emergency response costs. Additionally, this amendment leaves in Oklahoma County that portion of May Avenue west of the centerline, which may result in shared costs with the County for maintenance and any potential costs for widening at some point in the future.

**b. Cost to Citizens/Business Community:** No direct costs known.


**c. Revenue Produced:** This amendment has no impact on prior revenue estimates.
