Resolution authorizing the purchase of emergency and rush response services to hazardous substances and pollutants from State Contract (COKC00578), estimated cost \$300,000, retroactive to July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025.

Purpose:

To purchase emergency and rush response services to hazardous substances and pollutants for City Departments and Trusts from a State Contract.

Background:

City Departments and Trusts have a continuing need to purchase emergency and rush response services to hazardous substances and pollutants, which are available through a State Contract. This agreement is also used for the cleanup of homeless camps.

The estimated cost for this State Contract is based on previous expenditures for this commodity. The City is under no obligation to purchase from this agreement. All purchases are subject to future appropriations and the availability of funds.
