Project Agreement with Oklahoma Department of Transportation, State Project J3-7933(004)AG, State Job No. 37933(04), Project PC-0688, Striping, along various Streetcar routes in Downtown and Bricktown. Ward 7.

**Location:**

Downtown and Bricktown

**Background:**

Federal funds for transportation projects are allocated to the Oklahoma City Metropolitan region through a variety of programs, including the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriation Act (CRRSAA) program. This is achieved by first being adopted in the Association of Central Oklahoma Government's (ACOG) Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), which is updated every two years. ACOG releases a call for projects to be submitted for consideration to be programmed and receive funding.

The City was awarded the federal grant funding to construct transportation facilities that are funded by the City through the Better Streets Safer City program. This project will include signage, signal modifications, and striping in multiple locations within Oklahoma City Streetcar route.

Construction is scheduled to begin Summer 2023 and be completed in late 2023.
