

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF GROUND MAINTENANCE EQUIPMENT AND SERVICES FROM STATE CONTRACT (COKC00530), ESTIMATED COST \$950,000, AUGUST 1, 2024 THROUGH JULY 31, 2025.

WHEREAS, the City and Trusts have a continuing need to purchase ground maintenance equipment and services which are available through a State contract; and

WHEREAS, the equipment purchased under this contract includes agriculture, tree, and brush maintenance equipment, attachments, accessories, parts, golf carts, ATV's, UTVs, utility vehicles, medical emergency utility carts, mowers, handheld grounds maintenance equipment and services including maintenance or repair, and warranty programs; and

WHEREAS, this contract is in conjunction with City agreements to ensure the availability of new equipment, parts, and services to facilitate the City's high-peak mowing season; and

WHEREAS, when similar supplies or services are sold by more than one supplier, departments will obtain quotes and purchase from the supplier offering the lowest price when the cost is greater than \$5,000 to ensure the greatest cost savings are provided to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City has a need for on-site services, the contracted vendor will be required to submit a current certificate of insurance, before performing any services on City or Trusts property; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost for this State contract is based on previous expenditures for this commodity; and

WHEREAS, the City and Trusts are under no obligation to purchase from this agreement; and

WHEREAS, all purchases are subject to the future appropriations and the availability of funds; and

WHEREAS, there is a continuing need for the procurement of these materials and services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of The City of Oklahoma City that they do hereby authorize the purchase of ground maintenance equipment and services from State contract (COKC00530), estimated cost \$950,000, August 1, 2024 through July 31, 2025.
