Request for Proposals with The City of Oklahoma City to be advertised, to provide a Dental Benefit Plan for The City of Oklahoma City and participating public trust employees, retirees and eligible dependents (RFP-OCMFA-042), effective January 1, 2026.

Purpose:

Advertise a Request for Proposal for a dental benefit plan for The City of Oklahoma City and participating public trust employees, retirees, and eligible dependents, effective January 1, 2026.

Background:

The City of Oklahoma City offers health, dental and life insurance coverage for its employees and retirees, and eligible employees and retirees of participating public trusts. In March 2020, a request-for-proposal was advertised for a dental benefit plan for The City. On October 27, 2020 (Item. MFA. D) the City Council and Trustees approved a five-year agreement with Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Oklahoma, a Division of Health Care Service Corporation.

The current contract with Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Oklahoma will expire on December 31, 2025, and staff believes that it is prudent to issue a request-for-proposal at this time.

Estimated Costs reflect both the employer and employee share. The City pays \$16.00 per active employee per month. Active employees pay the remaining cost of their selected plan. Retirees pay 100% of selected plan cost.

Year 1: \$ 4,100,000 (\$3,000,000 OCMFA, \$1,100,000 OPEBT)
