Renewal No. 2 of pricing agreement, Oklahoma Cement Solutions (COKC00130), cementitious slurry stabilized subgrade, estimated cost \$200,000, April 11, 2025 through April 10, 2026.

Background:

The pricing agreement was originally awarded March 1, 2022 (Item No. IX. H.) for the period ended April 10, 2024. The pricing agreement was renewed on April 9, 2024 (Item No. IX. A.) for the period ending April 10, 2025. The pricing agreement included two one-year renewal options. This is the second renewal option.

The pricing agreement meets the City's policy on renewal of contracts for goods and services. Staff notified the vendor the City wishes to renew the pricing agreement under the same terms and conditions as previously awarded. A letter agreeing to the renewal has been received from the vendor. The vendor was granted a 2.78% price increase on their product; the increase is in line with industry standards. Estimates show the price increase will not affect the projected overall yearly expenditure.

The estimated cost for this pricing agreement is based on previous expenditure for this commodity. There is no obligation to purchase from this agreement. All purchases are subject to future appropriations and the availability of funds.
