Revocable Pipeline Permit with Blue Mountain Midstream, LLC to construct, operate and maintain a 6-inch steel pipe for natural gas, crossing south of the intersection of South Richland Road and SW 104th Street. Ward 3.

Location:

Natural gas pipeline crossing 677.30 feet south of the intersection of South Richland Road and SW 104th Street.

Background:

To construct, operate and maintain a pipeline on a portion of the City's rights-of-way and utility easements. This permit is for a 6-inch steel natural gas pipeline. The pipeline crossing length is 70 feet, a total of 4 rods.

It is expressly agreed that in the event the City makes a request to relocate said appurtenances to the company's pipeline operation located in City right-of-way/utility easement, the company will comply and relocate the appurtenances and bear the entire cost. The crossings are to be placed a minimum of 10 feet below grade in the right-of-way/utility easement.

Revenue:

Initial inspection and regulation fee of \$26.50 per rod for pipelines laid in City right-of-way/utility easement. All revenue is to be deposited in the General Fund – General Operations – Leases-Pipeline Inspection (OCITY-001-0001-43600004).
