Ordinance to be introduced and set for final hearing establishing establishing 90 degree angle parking within a setback parking area on the south side of NE 19th Street from approximately 45 feet west to 56 feet west of the west curb line of North Lottie Avenue. Ward 7

**Originating Department:** Public Works

**Description of Impact**

Geoffrey Butler, Planning Director, has submitted a request to restructure North Lottie Avenue from a four-lane roadway to a two-lane roadway with parking protected bicycle lanes on both sides of the street as a part of Oklahoma City Project PC-0738, Lottie Bicycle Infrastructure Project.

90 degree angle parking within a setback parking area on the south side of NE 19th Street from approximately 45 feet west to 56 feet west of the west curb line of North Lottie Avenue will provide a replacement angle parking area best suited to match existing conditions and meet the intent of the City's proposed on-street angle parking standards.

At their regular meeting on October 16, 2023, the Oklahoma City Traffic and Transportation Commission voted in favor of the requested change and recommended it for approval by the City Council.
