Ordinance to be introduced and set for final hearing on March 26, 2024, establishing a reserved parking space for the physically disabled on the west side of North Hudson Avenue from approximately 32 feet south to 59 feet south of the south curb line of NW 11th Street. Ward 6.

Background:

Timothy W. Johnson, P.E., President of Johnson and Associates, Inc., on behalf of their client, Family Justice Center, has submitted a request for a reserved parking space for the physically disabled within the limits of existing on-street parallel parking on the west side of North Hudson Avenue south of NW 11th Street. The requested location is adjacent to the future site of the Family Justice Center.

At their regular meeting on February 19, 2024, the Oklahoma City Traffic and Transportation Commission voted in favor of the request and recommended it for approval by the City Council.
