**Re: Project MC-0749, Oklahoma City Riversport Improvements, 800 Riversport Drive**

We have been asked to assess if Hydrostadium are a sole source for the Omniflotts whitewater obstacle system. I can supply the following information.

The sport's governing body, the International Canoe Federations (ICF), dictates what equipment is permitted in their 'Canoe Slalom Homologated Sports Equipment List', which specifies what Whitewater Stadium Obstacles must be used. Two manufacturers are listed: EPD (which supply RapidBlocs), and Hydrostadium (which supply Omniflotts).

Hydrostadium is a wholly owned subsidiary of French energy company Électricité de France (EDF).

Hydrostadium design, manufacture, and supply the Omniflotts obstacle system. This comes in a variety of types, but chiefly under current consideration on the Oklahoma City Riversport Improvements project are the 'Omniflot III' and 'Insert I' components. Hydrostadium took out the Patent on the system (see attached), and by their own assertion—and to the best of our knowledge having researched the matter—are the sole source these products worldwide.
