Concurrence with the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust in accepting Project WC-0950-2, Waterline Replacement, West Hefner Road to Morton Avenue from North Florida Avenue to North Brauer Avenue, NW 115th Street to NW 109th Street from Pennsylvania Avenue to Villa Avenue; and placing the maintenance bond into effect. Ward 7.

Purpose:

To close out the project and place the maintenance bond into effect.

Background:

This project replaced 11,352 linear feet of 8-inch waterline and included two separate waterline replacement areas identified with high rates of water main breaks and leaks.

Fidelity and Deposit Company of Maryland is the surety company for the two-year maintenance bond. Bond No. 9432186 will remain in effect until the contractor and surety have fulfilled all responsibilities under the maintenance bond.
