

**RESOLUTION AMENDING THE COMMUNITY SECTION OF THE
MAPS 4 IMPLEMENTATION PLAN TO REVISE THE PLAN TO
CONSTRUCT ONE MAPS 4 MENTAL HEALTH CRISIS CENTER
INSTEAD OF TWO CENTERS AND COMBINING THE BUDGETS.**

WHEREAS, City Council approved the MAPS 4 Implementation Plan on September 14, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the MAPS 4 Implementation Plan was amended on November 9, 2021 to remove the Freedom Center from the MAPS 4 Program, and all funding was allocated to the Clara Luper Civil Rights Center; and

WHEREAS, the original proposal for the MAPS 4 Mental Health package included two Crisis Centers intended to contain 16 stabilization beds each; and

WHEREAS, Oklahoma State Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (OSDMHSAS) sought and received a waiver (effective January 1, 2021) from the United States Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services, which, among other things, removed the 16-bed limit; and

WHEREAS, on January 16, 2024, the City Council approved the Memorandum of Understanding with ODMHSAS as the operator of the MAPS 4 Mental Health Crisis Center No. 1; and

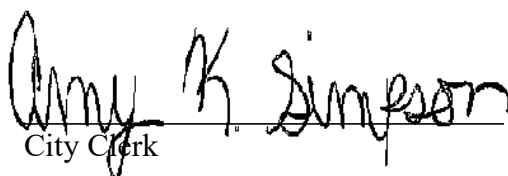
WHEREAS, ODMHSAS has requested that the two crisis centers be combined to reduce duplication of administrative space and to allow more of the construction budget to be focused on the delivery of much needed crisis beds; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the MAPS 4 Program to combine the two MAPS 4 Mental Health Crisis Centers into one, which should help get more than the proposed 32 beds, and to combine the budgets.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of The City of Oklahoma City that the Community Section of the MAPS 4 Implementation Plan be amended to construct one MAPS 4 Mental Health Crisis Center and the budgets be combined.

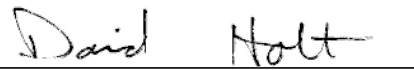

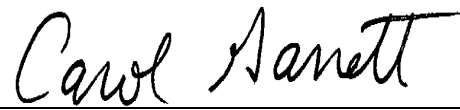
