Concurrence with the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust in adopting a Resolution ratifying the actions of the General Manager in waiving competitive bidding and issuing emergency purchase order EPO01052024SMK06 to Rangeline Utility Services, LLC for a main break repair at NW 12th Street and Pennsylvania Avenue, \$246,000. Ward 6.

Location:

NW 12th Street and Pennsylvania Avenue

Purpose:

To ratify the actions of the General Manager in issuing an emergency purchase order.

Justification:

To complete an emergency repair on a 20-inch water main break.

Background:

On January 4, 2024, a water main break was discovered and crews were unable to make necessary repairs. On January 5, 2024, a request was submitted to the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust General Manager to authorize an emergency purchase order for Rangeline Utility Services, LLC. The contractor performed a line stop and installed a valve on the 20-inch main at NW 10th Street and Pennsylvania Avenue so that utility crews could repair the main break. The line stop was removed by the contractor after the valve was installed.

It was in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare that repairs be done timely to restore the operational capacity in the area.
