## The City of OKLAHOMA CITY

Resolution approving a sole source Oklahoma Law Enforcement Telecommunication System User Agency Agreement for access to the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Telecommunication System from the Oklahoma Department of Public Safety (SS23-C231026), estimated cost \$153,600, retroactive to July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023.

### **Background:**

The Oklahoma Department of Safety (DPS) operates the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Telecommunication Systems (OLETS), which includes interface with the National Crime Information Center (NCIC), the National Law Enforcement Telecommunication System (NLETS). The Department of Public Safety Computer Files (SAFECON), the Oklahoma Tax Commission Vehicle Registration Files (VREG), the Juvenile Online Tracking System (JOLTS), and criminal justice information. DPS allows law enforcement agencies and certain other criminal justice entities access to OLETS for the purpose of the administration of criminal justice upon execution of required DPS User Agreements.

In April of 2017, the State passed Senate Bill No. 28 allowing the DPS to increase certain fees on the OLETS use for Oklahoma law enforcement agencies.

The estimated cost for FY 2023 access is \$153,600. Included in this estimate are seven full access terminals located in the Crime Information Unit at \$350 each per month, one CAD terminal server at \$300 each annually, 266 Query LITE Terminals at \$25 each per month, and 850 MDC at \$5 each per month.

OLETS provides a computerized message switching system to provide for the interstate, intrastate and interagency exchange of criminal justice related information 24 hours a day, seven days a week and is a vital tool for the daily operation of the Department. The DPS is the sole source provider of law enforcement telecommunications systems for the State of Oklahoma.

Staff requests Council approve a sole source Oklahoma Law Enforcement Telecommunication System User Agency Agreement for access to the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Telecommunication System from the Oklahoma Department of Public Safety (SS23-C231026), estimated cost \$153,600, retroactive to July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023.
