I. SCOPE

Change Order No. 8 adds new pay items to the contract.

II. JUSTIFICATION

Change Order No. 8 provides for additional millwork days, fire alarm cell dialer, driving range sod credit, function lawn zoysia sod, dedication plaque, 3rd point of sale for golf shop, miscellaneous items for occupancy, earthwork for north half, fans in hitting pavilion, builders risk insurance and repairs for temporary trailer.

V. CONTRACT TIME

The original contract called for 365 calendar days. Change Order No. 8 adds 52 days due to additional scope changes requested by the City. An additional 793 calendar days were added to the contract with Change Orders No. 1 through 8. The total contract duration is now 1,210 calendar days.




