Resolution amending the prior resolution adopted on December 17, 2019 declaring the need for the adoption of the International Residential Code for One-and Two-Family Dwellings, 2015 Edition, and providing certain local amendments to said Code.

Purpose:

To further amend the previously adopted amendments to the 2015 International Residential Code for One-and Two-Family Dwellings as previously adopted by Council on December 17, 2019.

Background:

On September 24, 2019, the Council adopted Ordinance No. 26,248 amending Chapter 12 of the Building Code which included the adoption of the 2015 Edition of the International Residential Code for One-and-Two-Family Dwellings and in conjunction with said Ordinance amendment, the Council adopted a Resolution declaring the need for the adoption of the International Residential Code for One-and-Two-Family Dwellings, 2015 Edition.

After adoption, staff learned certain local amendments were inadvertently left out of said Resolution. On December 17, 2019, the Council repealed and replaced the previously adopted Resolution to provide for certain local amendments to said Code.

One portion of the code, Table R301.2(1) Climatic and Geographic Design Criteria, was indicated as requiring an ice barrier underlayment. It is the desire of Council to correct this section to remove the requirement and to leave all other sections of the Resolution intact.
