Joint Resolution with The City of Oklahoma City authorizing the Risk Manager and the Trust's legal counsel to enter into a Joint Petition Settlement of the Workers' Compensation Commission Claim No. CM3-2022-04815E styled: *Jacob Cole, Claimant vs. The City of Oklahoma City, Respondent*, an Own Risk Carrier, and further authorizing the Municipal Counselor to assist said counsel in the rendition of said Joint Petition Settlement to Judgment as authorized by 85 O.S. §346, 62 O.S. §§365.1 *et seq.* and Article 10, Section 28 of the Oklahoma Constitution.

Background:

The Claimant, Jacob Cole is 41 years old and is an 18-year employee of The City of Oklahoma City. At the time of the injury he was assigned to the Police Department as a Sergeant and continues to be employed by the City.

Claimant sustained an undisputed accidental injury on July 29, 2022 to his left knee. The Claimant required surgery to his left knee on August 3, 2022 and December 16, 2022.

Claimant was evaluated by Dr. Lance Rosson on behalf of his attorney and found to have the following permanent partial impairment: left knee 42%. The claimant was also evaluated by Dr. Robert Griffith on behalf of the City and found to have the following permanent partial impairment: left knee 2%. The negotiated Joint Petition Settlement calls for a PPD award of \$19,800 for the following permanent partial disability: left knee 20%.

The settlement further calls for a 3% assessment of the PPD award in the sum of \$594 be deducted and paid on behalf of the claimant for the Multiple Injury Trust Fund Tax, making the lump sum award \$19,206. The settlement further calls for \$3,960 to be deducted from the PPD award and paid in a lump sum to the Claimant's attorney as a fair and reasonable fee. In addition, the City will pay Court costs \$140, a Special Occupational and Safety Fund tax representing .75% of the permanent partial disability award, shall be paid in the sum of \$148.50 and the Workers' Compensation Administration Fund, representing 2% of the permanent partial disability award, shall be paid in the sum of \$396.
