Concurrence with the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust in approving Amendment No. 5 to Contract for Engineering Services with C.H. Guernsey & Company, Project WC-0853, 48-inch water transmission main, Booster Station No. 9, 7626 West Reno Avenue to Booster Station No. 28, 501 North Council Road, fee increase of \$27,106. Wards 1 and 3.

Location:

Booster Station No. 9, 7626 West Reno Avenue to Booster Station No. 28, 501 North Council Road

Background:

This project provides for the Engineer's design and all other engineering services related to the alignment and construction of approximately 1.2 miles of 48-inch water transmission main at the above location. This water transmission main will allow water from the Draper service area to be transmitted to the Hefner service area and vice versa.

Subsequent to execution of the original contract as previously amended, and due to property development within the project limits, it has been determined that a portion of the proposed waterline must be re-aligned to avoid the new development. The Engineer will be required to provide additional design, survey of the new alignment area, and a new easement form to reflect the revised legal description. The original contract must be amended to provide for the Engineer's increased scope of work as outlined above and associated fees.
