- The Firefighter or the department will be required to purchase PlatinumED for \$33 for each student.
- The Firefighter or the department must purchase an EOC student clinical polo shirt that must be worn during their program clinicals. Triple Elite is the supplier for the \$29 EOC polo.
- The firefighter must also have in their possession a stethoscope, penlight, trauma shears, and a wrist watch during their clinical rotations.
- The EOC EMT course consists of 199 didactic hours (online), 80 lab hours, 36 clinical hours, and 8 hours for the NREMT psychomotor exam for a total of 323 hours.
- The firefighter or the department will be responsible for providing evidence of a Group One Federal background check for each student. The background checks must not be older than six months prior to the class start date.
- The firefighter or the department will be responsible for providing evidence of a urinalysis drug screening for each student, at least within the last six months.
- The firefighter or the department will be responsible for providing a copy of the following vaccinations.
 - Three (3) Hepatitis B shot series OR Titer OR sign a Hepatitis B Waiver.
 - Two (2) MMR vaccines or Titer.
 - Two (2) Varicella Vaccinations or Varicella Titer. A history alone of Varicella (Chicken Pox) is NOT acceptable.
 - Tetanus booster within the last 10 years.
 - Flu shot – *must be current year vaccine (for Fall class you will need to provide proof you have received the vaccination when it becomes available).*
 - TB – 1 IGRA Blood Test within the last 12 months or 2 skin tests both of which cannot expire during the program.
 - Currently the COVID vaccination is not required to attend EOC's EMT Class, however if you have the vaccination you can provide a copy with your vaccinations listed above.

***NOTE:** EOC Tech does not invoice for background check, drug screen, vaccinations, My Clinical Exchange fees, or shirts. The student will be responsible for paying those facilities directly and be

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reimbursed by the City upon receiving signed receipt from the student. Books and stethoscopes will be paid for directly to the specific vendors by the Fire Department.
