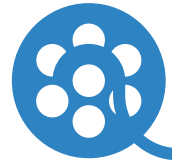

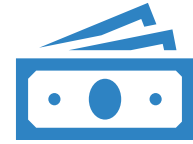
PROJECT DESCRIPTION

PROJECT QUALIFICATIONS

Feature Film with total Qualified Expenditures of at least \$500,000

- Project High Plains is anticipated to have local qualified expenditures of \$4,733,748

Pre-Qualifications for Incentive Award

- Expenditures of at least \$500,000 on a feature film
- 50% of filming days in OKC
- Main production office located within city limits of OKC (Allsweet)
- Pre-qualified for the State of Oklahoma's film incentive

Eligible to receive up to 5% rebate of eligible expenditures

- Recommended Rebate Allocation for Project Silence: \$236,687
