

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE USE OF EXCESS OKLAHOMA CITY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS SALES TAX COLLECTIONS AND/OR INTEREST IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,288.45 TO PURCHASE A FITNESS EQUIPMENT OPERATING SYSTEM, PROJECT M3-H004, MAPS 3 SENIOR HEALTH AND WELLNESS CENTER NO. 3.

WHEREAS, on December 8, 2009, the voters of The City of Oklahoma City voted to approve the levy of the Oklahoma City Capital Improvements Sales Tax for the MAPS 3 Program; and

WHEREAS, the MAPS 3 Program includes new senior health and wellness centers; and

WHEREAS, the MAPS 3 Senior Health and Wellness Center No. 3, Project M3-H004, is completed; and

WHEREAS, due to budget constraints, some of the furniture, fixtures, and equipment were removed from the scope of work and will be purchased from City annual contracts for Project M3-H004; and

WHEREAS, to fund the purchase of a fitness equipment operating system for Project M3-H004, excess Oklahoma City Capital Improvement sales tax collections and/or interest in the amount of \$15,288.45 must be allocated to the MAPS 3 Senior Health and Wellness Center No. 3 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of The City of Oklahoma City the use of excess Oklahoma City Capital Improvement sales tax collections and/or interest in the amount of \$15,288.45 be authorized to fund the purchase of a fitness equipment operating system for Project M3-H004, MAPS 3 Senior Health and Wellness Center No. 3.
