Ratifying and approving Addendum No. 1; awarding a construction contract to Oshkosh AeroTech, LLC, Project No. OCAT WRWA 2418, Passenger Boarding Bridge Replacement – Phase II, \$3,340,999; and approving the Contract and bonds.

Location:

Will Rogers World Airport

Background:

On November 16, 2023, Trust authorized the advertisement for Project No. OCAT WRWA 2418, Passenger Boarding Bridge Replacement – Phase II (Project) at Will Rogers World Airport (Airport).

There are 17 passenger boarding bridges at the Airport that are beyond their useful serviceable life requiring replacement. This Project will replace three passenger boarding bridges that are beyond their useful serviceable life and which require replacement.

JBT Aerotech Corporation's bid was submitted under John Bean Technologies Corporation and was the lowest and best bid at Bid Opening which occurred on December 20, 2023. In the interim, on February 16, 2024, JBT Aerotech Corporation was converted to Oshkosh AeroTech, LLC. Due to this conversion, Oshkosh AeroTech, LLC, is the same entity as JBT Aerotech Corporation.

This Project is contingent on funding by the Federal Aviation Administration and Oklahoma City Airport Trust funds.
