Revocable Permit with The Susan G. Komen Breast Cancer Foundation for the "OKC More Than Pink Walk," October 19, 2024, Bicentennial Park, 500 Couch Drive, revenue of \$1,425. Ward 6.

Location:

Bicentennial Park, located at 500 Couch Drive

Background:

The Susan G. Komen Breast Cancer Foundation (Permittee) desires a Revocable Permit (Permit) to hold the "OKC More Than Pink Walk" (Event), as described above. Permittee will, at its expense, plan, organize, and manage the Event.

The Permit will be effective when approved by the City. It will authorize Permittee to use the Bicentennial Park area from 11:00 a.m. on Friday, October 18, 2024 until 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 19, 2024.

In addition to the rights granted herein, this Permit shall authorize Permittee to use public rights-of-way to create an **Event Staging Area**, exclusively closing Couch Drive from Channing Drive east to North Walker Avenue, North Walker Avenue from Couch Drive south to Colcord Drive, and Colcord Drive from Channing Drive east to North Walker Avenue; to create a **Course Route**, temporarily closing Colcord Drive from North Walker Avenue west to Shartel Avenue, Shartel Avenue from Colcord Drive north to Northwest 4th Street, Northwest 4th Street from Shartel Avenue east to North Walker Avenue, North Walker Avenue from Northwest 4th Street south to Colcord Drive, Colcord Drive from North Walker Avenue west to South Lee Avenue, South Lee Avenue from Colcord Drive south to West Sheridan Avenue, West Sheridan Avenue from South Lee Avenue west to North Classen Boulevard, the northbound lanes North Classen Boulevard from West Sheridan Avenue north to Northwest 6th Street, Northwest 6th Street from North Classen Avenue east to North Walker Avenue, and North Walker Avenue from Northwest 6th Street south to Colcord Avenue.

Permittee must provide required insurance and indemnification; protect City property; and comply with applicable laws, rules, and regulations. As consideration, Permittee will pay the City \$1425.

Revenue:

\$1425 to be deposited in the General Operations - Culture and Recreation - Parks Charges-Special Events (1001 - REV1500 - 42050011)
