

RESOLUTION DECLARING 45,000 SQUARE FEET HILOAD SHORING SYSTEM OBSOLETE AND SURPLUS TO THE NEEDS OF THE OKLAHOMA CITY PUBLIC PROPERTY AUTHORITY, AND AUTHORIZING DISPOSAL OF SAID EQUIPMENT BY PUBLIC AUCTION.

WHEREAS, this equipment (See Attachment A) was originally purchased in April 2022 for the Stage 4 (Arena) flooring; and

WHEREAS, the site is being redeveloped and the scaffolding system is expected to generate revenue more than \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, purchasing policies and procedures require staff to obtain approval prior to selling surplus property with a value expected to exceed \$50,000; and


WHEREAS, revenues collected from the sale of this surplus equipment will be returned to the fund from which the equipment was originally purchased; and

WHEREAS, staff requests Council declare the obsolete equipment as surplus and authorize disposal by public auction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Oklahoma City Public Property Authority that they do hereby declare 45,000 square feet Hiload shoring system obsolete and surplus to the needs of the Oklahoma City Public Property Authority, and authorizing disposal of said equipment by public auction.
