Joint Resolution with the Oklahoma City Municipal Facilities Authority authorizing The City of Oklahoma City to use Streets Proposition General Obligation Bond Funds to purchase right-of-way and permanent easements from the Oklahoma City Municipal Facilities Authority in the amount of \$45,000 for Project PC-0558, roadway widening and improvements, SW 15th Street from South Mustang Road to John Kilpatrick Turnpike, and the Oklahoma City Municipal Facilities Authority accepting said payment. Ward 3.

Location:

SW 15th Street from South Mustang Road to John Kilpatrick Turnpike

Background:

This 2017 General Obligation Bond project provides for the street widening of SW 15th Street from South Mustang Road to John Kilpatrick Turnpike. Improvements will include widening of the roadway from 2 lanes to 4 lanes, providing a storm drainage system and new sidewalk improvements. Before the project was fully funded with bond funds, the OCMFA agreed to purchase the right-of-way and easements necessary for the bond project. Now that the bond project is fully funded, it is the City's desire to purchase the easements and right-of-way from the OCMFA.

Final plans are expected by early 2023, with construction expected to start Fall 2023.
