Revocable Right-of-Way Use Permit with With Love OKC, to hold “Juneteenth on the East,” June 15, 2024, NE 23rd Street between North Kelham Avenue and North Missouri Avenue, revenue of \$400. Ward 7.

NE 23rd Street between North Kelham Avenue and North Missouri Avenue, Northeast OKC

Background:

“Juneteenth on the East” is an annual community event celebrating Juneteenth and brings together artists from many different art forms: including music, dance, poetry, visual art and more. This is the 4th year for the event which features food trucks, pop-up vendors, live music, an interactive community mural project, and children’s activities.

The event will be open to the public from 3 p.m. to 9 p.m. The revocable permit would become effective in advance of the event at 6 a.m. on Saturday and authorizes the closure until 6 a.m. on Sunday, allowing sufficient time for setup, teardown and cleanup of the event.
