

RESOLUTION OF THE OKLAHOMA CITY WATER UTILITIES TRUST EXTENDING TIME TO AWARD CONTRACT, AWARDING A CONTRACT TO KRAPFF-REYNOLDS CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, PROJECT SC-1095, SANITARY SEWER REHABILITATION, NORTH WESTERN AVENUE TO NORTH BLACKWELDER AVENUE FROM NORTHWEST EXPRESSWAY TO I-44, \$2,336,771.50; AND APPROVING THE CONTRACT AND BONDS.

WHEREAS, Project SC-1095 provides for the rehabilitation of 3,680 linear feet of sanitary sewer main due to deterioration; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust (OCWUT) has advertised and received bids for Project SC-1095; and

WHEREAS, the Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974 states that a contract for construction of a public improvement must be awarded within 30 days or within 45 days for good cause shown or within 120 days upon mutual agreement between the lowest responsible bidder and the awarding public agency or agencies; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of OCWUT to award the contract to the lowest and best responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the bids were opened on November 1, 2023; and

WHEREAS, this contract was delayed due to necessary review period requirements and the meeting schedule of the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust; therefore, preventing award within 30 days of receipt of bids; and

WHEREAS, a letter agreeing to honor the bid for 30 days has been received from Krapff-Reynolds Construction Company.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Trustees of the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust that they do hereby extend time to award contract, award a contract to Krapff-Reynolds Construction Company, Project SC-1095, Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation, North Western Avenue to North Blackwelder Avenue from Northwest Expressway to I-44, \$2,336,771.50; and approve the contract and bonds.
