**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL COUNSELOR TO CONFESS JUDGMENT WITHOUT ADMITTING LIABILITY IN THE MATTER OF *CHARLOTTE ROSKO, VICTORIA ROSKO, AND WILLIAM ROSKO, INDIVIDUALLY v. CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY*, OKLAHOMA COUNTY DISTRICT CASE NUMBER CJ-2022-4166.**

**WHEREAS**, the lawsuit styled *Charlotte Rosko, Victoria Rosko, and William Rosko, Individually v. City of Oklahoma City* has been filed in the District Court for Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma;

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined that a settlement of One Hundred and Eighty Three Dollars (\$183,000) is a just and reasonable settlement of said case;

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the City Council to make such settlement by authorizing the Municipal Counselor to draft the necessary paperwork to settle this case and to prepare and file a Journal Entry of Judgment, which does not admit liability in said case.


