Amendment Nos. 1, 10, 12, 13, and 14 to the Award/Contract (SP0600-20-C-8331) associated with the United States of America for the municipalization of the water and wastewater systems at Tinker Air Force Base.

Location:

Tinker Air Force Base

Background:

On August 4, 2020, The City of Oklahoma City (City) and the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust (OCWUT) authorized the execution of the Award/Contract (contract) with the United States of America (Government) for the municipalization of the water and wastewater systems at Tinker Air Force Base. The contract was fully executed on August 25, 2020.

The contract permits the Government to unilaterally make administrative amendments to the contract. Upon execution, copies of these amendments are furnished to the City and OCWUT for their records. The Government does not mandate the City or OCWUT to return an executed copy. However, it has been determined that it is beneficial for the City and OCWUT to formally approve these administrative amendments in a manner consistent with bilateral amendments.

Amendment No. 1, effective May 26, 2021, adds DFAR Clause 252.204-7020, NIST SP 800-171 DoD Assessment Requirements, in accordance with FAR §1.108(d)(3) and as prescribed in DFARS §204.7304, Solicitation Provisions and Contract Clauses.

Amendment No. 10, effective June 23, 2023, adds FAR Clause 52.204-27 Prohibition on a Bytedance Covered Application that prohibits the use of TikTok and related applications on information technology equipment or systems used under a federal contract.

Amendment No. 12, effective November 7, 2023, revises the Schedule and Accounting and Appropriation Data section of the contract.

Amendment No. 13, effective November 21, 2023, revises the Accounting and Appropriation Data section of the contract.

Amendment No. 14, effective December 14, 2023, updates the Department of Labor Davis Bacon Water Determination rates in accordance with 29 CFR 5.5(a) and 29 CFR 1.6(f).
