Resolution authorizing the acceptance of a \$356,324.05 grant from the Oklahoma Highway Safety Office, equipment, training and certification sessions for the Oklahoma Impaired Driving Enforcement Drug Recognition Program; ratifying submittal of the internet based application by the Chief of Police and the Police Department Business Manager; authorizing the Mayor to sign any necessary documents; authorizing the Police Business Manager or Management Specialist to submit the internet acceptance, requests for funds, provide reports as required, and to administer the grant; and authorizing the City Treasurer to receive and deposit the funds in the Grants Management Fund.

Background:

This grant provides funding for the Oklahoma Impaired Driving Enforcement Drug Recognition Program (DRE). The DRE program is designed to assist in the identification and evaluation of drivers suspected to be under the influence of drugs leading to prosecution and adjudication of these impaired drivers, as directed by the Oklahoma Highway Safety Office (OHSO). The grant period is October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025. This will be the seventh year of funding for this grant. The grant provides funding of \$356,324.05 for the Oklahoma City Police Department to coordinate and conduct training classes and certification sessions to train officers from various agencies in the state to become Drug Recognition Trainers and Experts to increase enforcement of DUI laws. The grant also provides the funding of a .85 FTE DRE State Coordinator and for the purchase of various supplies and equipment.

No City match is required for this grant from the OHSO.
