Contract award and approval, Nomad GCS (C244002), one Tactical Command Vehicle, \$698,424.88.

### **Purpose:**

To purchase a tactical command vehicle that will replace the Police Department Tactical Division's 20 year old unit. The vehicle will be used to coordinate the safe apprehension of criminal suspects.

### **Bidding Information:**

The specifications were advertised in the Journal Record and posted in the electronic bidding system. Forty-two potential bidders viewed the specifications with two bids submitted.

Addendum No. 1 was issued to extend the bid closing date from December 6, 2023 to December 13, 2023. As of December 5, 2023, no bids had been submitted. In extending the bid by one week, it allowed two bids to be submitted.

Staff is recommending award to the lowest and best bidder meeting the requirements of the specifications, Nomad GCS.

This contract will be in effect from January 30, 2024 through delivery of the equipment or January 1, 2025, whichever occurs later. Additional unit(s) may be purchased from this contract providing the vendor agrees to offer the equipment at the same contract price. Any future purchase is subject to future appropriations and the availability of funds.
