Resolution authorizing the purchase of Boomi software maintenance and support from OMNIA Partners public sector purchasing cooperative (COKC01117), estimated cost \$145,000, November 21, 2024 through November 20, 2025.

Purpose:

To provide ongoing Boomi software maintenance and support services for the Information Technology Department.

Background:

Boomi software is utilized to manage data integrations between IT applications for use by City departments and is used in conjunction with several projects by the Utilities Department. Boomi software is a middleware that connects different systems to allow for easier integration, creation, and management. The integrations are what allow data to be transferred back and forth.

This City will be purchasing from an existing government contract through OMNIA Partners public sector purchasing cooperative. This contract provides access to discounted pricing from Dell Marketing LP. OMNIA Partners is a purchasing cooperative benefitting public agencies by providing national pricing through competitively solicited proposals. The approval of this contract follows the same procedures when purchasing from State contracts.

The estimated cost for this cooperative contract is based on anticipated expenditures for this commodity. The City is under no obligation to purchase from this contract. All purchases are subject to future appropriations and the availability of funds.
