Resolution authorizing an amendment of a \$194,000 grant from the Oklahoma Highway Safety Office by accepting an additional \$105,502.85; approving the amended Grant Agreement; authorizing the Mayor to sign any necessary documents; and authorizing the City Treasurer to receive and deposit the funds in the Grants Management Fund.

Background:

A resolution authorizing acceptance of a \$194,000 grant from the Oklahoma Highway Safety Office previously approved by City Council on August 15, 2023 (Item No.VII.CH.)

This grant provides funding for the Oklahoma Impaired Driving Enforcement Drug Recognition Program (DRE). The DRE program is designed to assist in the identification and evaluation of drivers suspected to be under the influence of drugs leading to prosecution and adjudication of these impaired drivers, as directed by the Oklahoma Highway Safety Office (OHSO). The grant period is October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2024. This will be the sixth year of funding for this grant. The grant provides funding for the Oklahoma City Police Department to coordinate and conduct training classes and certification sessions to train officers from various agencies in the state to become Drug Recognition Trainers and Experts to increase enforcement of DUI laws.

The grant award is being increased by \$105,502.85 to provide partial funding for a Drug Recognition Expert Coordinator.

No City match is required for this grant from the OHSO.
