Concurrence with the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust in approving the Plans and Specifications to be advertised for bids, Project ST-0167-2, Disinfection and Dechlorination Improvements, Groundwater Well Improvements, North Canadian Wastewater Treatment Plant. Ward 7.

Location:

North Canadian Wastewater Treatment Plant

Purpose:

To approve the plans and specifications and advertise for bids.

Background:

To ensure a reliable water source for the new disinfection and dechlorination systems, the east groundwater well must be rehabilitated, and the west well must be replaced. The east well has not been used in several years and has not been rehabilitated since installment. The west well has been operating continuously and is nearing the end of its service life. This bid package is a component of a larger project at the North Canadian Wastewater Treatment Plant to replace the current disinfection and dechlorination systems with new on-site sodium hypochlorite generation and sodium bisulfite systems.
