Concurrence with the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust in ratifying and approving Addenda Nos. 1 through 3; awarding a contract to Southwest Water Works, LLC, Project WC-1095, Waterline Replacement, along Barr Avenue and Nicklas Avenue between NW 39th Street and NW 36th Street, along SW 38th Street and SW 40th Street between Blackwelder Avenue and Douglas Avenue, \$1,925,755; and approving the contract and bonds. Wards 2 and 6.

Location:

Along Barr Avenue and Nicklas Avenue between NW 39th Street and NW 36th Street
Along SW 38th Street and SW 40th Street between Blackwelder Avenue and Douglas Avenue

Background:

The project replaces approximately 4,986 feet of 2-inch, 4-inch, and 6-inch waterlines due to deterioration. It is in the best interest of the public's health, safety, and welfare that the replacements be done timely to restore the operational capacity of the water system.

The addenda were required to modify and clarify plans and specifications, and answer questions from potential bidders. The addenda modifications take precedence over the original plans and specifications.
