Revocable Right-of-Way Use Permit with Stockyards City Main Street, Inc. to hold the "Stockyards City St. Patrick's Day Parade," March 16, 2024, Exchange Avenue between South Pennsylvania Avenue and South Agnew Avenue, revenue of \$250. Ward 6.

**Location:**

Exchange Avenue between South Pennsylvania Avenue and South Agnew Avenue, the westbound lanes of Exchange Avenue between South Pennsylvania Avenue and South Kentucky Avenue, and South Agnew Avenue between Exchange Avenue and SW 15th Street, Stockyards City

**Background:**

The "Stockyards City St. Patrick's Day Parade" is a community event presented by Stockyards City Main Street. This will be the fifth year for this annual event in Stockyards City. The parade will begin with a procession of longhorn cattle followed by entries from various local clubs/organizations.

A clean up team will participate in the parade and clean up after the animals.

The parade will start at 10 a.m. The street closures would be authorized from 9:45 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., allowing sufficient time for staging, setup, teardown and cleanup.
