Title of Item: Ordinance relating to General Schedule of Fees for Building, Electrical, Plumbing, and Mechanical Board of Appeals; amending Chapter 60 of the Oklahoma City Municipal Code, 2020, by repealing Title 12, Article II, Section 60-12-14 through 60-12-18, Title 18, Article I, Sections 60-18-1 through 60-18-5, Title 29, Articles II and III, Sections 60-29-6 through 60-29-15, and Title 42, Article II, Sections 60-42-12 through 60-42-15 in its entirety; enacting a new Title 12, Article II, Section 60-12-14 through 60-12-18, title 18, Article I, Sections 60-18-1 through 60-18-5, Title 29, Articles II and III, Sections 60-29-6 through 60-29-15, and Title 42, Article II, Sections 60-42-12 through 60-42-15 of Chapter 60 of the Oklahoma City Municipal code, 2020; and providing for an effective date; and declaring an emergency.
