

RESOLUTION APPROVING A SOLE SOURCE SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH YWCA OKLAHOMA CITY, INC. TO PROVIDE A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE VICTIM'S ASSISTANCE PROGRAM, RETROACTIVE JULY 1, 2022 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2023, \$97,578.

WHEREAS, this Services Agreement will provide a comprehensive Domestic Violence Victim's Assistance Program; and

WHEREAS, this program will assure victims of domestic violence/abuse that they are supported by their City and through this support, it will create an atmosphere of safe choices; and

WHEREAS, this agreement provides for two one-year renewal options; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department has contracted with the YWCA since 1994 to provide services to domestic violence victims and the YWCA provides training to the other agencies that refer victims to the YWCA; and

WHEREAS, over the years, the Police Department has developed a very good working relationship with the YWCA, including the donation of used cell phones that are reprogrammed to dial 911 only, and are provided to victims of domestic violence; and

WHEREAS, the victim's services provided will encompass a variety of areas and this program will be housed at the Family Justice Center; and

WHEREAS, staff is of the opinion that it will not be advantageous for the City to advertise this item to request proposals because no other vendor submitted a proposal when it was last advertised and staff is not aware of any other vendors who can provide these services; and

WHEREAS, staff requests Council approve a resolution authorizing a sole source Services Agreement for a Domestic Violence Victim's Assistance Program with the YWCA of Oklahoma City, Inc., estimated cost \$97,578; and

WHEREAS, there is a continuing need for the purchase of these services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of The City of Oklahoma City that they do hereby authorize approval of a sole source Services Agreement with YWCA Oklahoma City, Inc. for a Domestic Violence Victim's Assistance Program, retroactive July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023, \$97,578.
