**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL COUNSELOR TO CONFESS JUDGMENT WITHOUT ADMITTING LIABILITY IN THE CASE OF *QUENEISHA WILLIAMS V. CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY*, OKLAHOMA COUNTY DISTRICT CASE NUMBER CJ-2023-3559.**

**WHEREAS**, the lawsuit styled *Queneisha Williams v. City of Oklahoma City* has been filed in the District Court for Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma;


**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined that a settlement of this lawsuit in the amount of THIRTY-ONE THOUSAND (\$31,000) dollars, is a just and reasonable settlement of said case;

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the City Council to make such settlement by authorizing the Municipal Counselor to draft the necessary paperwork to settle this case and to prepare and file a Journal Entry of Judgment, which does not admit liability in said case.
