WASTEWATER TREATED

The Wastewater Quality Division treated approximately 1.9 billion gallons of wastewater during July 2024, a decrease of approximately 761 million gallons from July 2023.

METERS

During July 2024, 405 meters were sold to contractors for installation, which is a 28.16 percent increase from July 2023. 405 meters have been sold fiscal year-to-date 2025, a 28.16 percent increase from the meter sales of fiscal year-to-date 2024.
