## The City of OKLAHOMA CITY

Amendment No. 1 and Restated Memorandum of Understanding with the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust, for the effective removal of trash, debris, brush and overgrowth on public property, and for requested graffiti abatement, not to exceed \$186,900, retroactive to April 8, 2025 through June 30, 2025.

### **Background:**

On August 13, 2024, the City Council (Item No. IX. BC) approved Amendment No. 5 and Restated Agreement with the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust (OCWUT) and Oklahoma County (OCWUT00052) for the effective removal of trash, debris, brush, and overgrowth on public property, and for graffiti abatement within areas of Oklahoma City located within Oklahoma County.

OCWUT has agreed to administer this agreement on behalf of The City of Oklahoma City (City) retroactively from July 1, 2024, and the City will transfer funds to OCWUT for the removal of trash, debris, and overgrowth on public property, graffiti, and related ancillary services.

The need exists for a Memorandum of Understanding between OCWUT and the City.
